By requesting a site to decorate, I understand the following: I/the organization will provide outdoor lights, outdoor extension cords, an outdoor timer, non-inflatable decorations, and signage identifying my organization for display from **Thanksgiving Day, 11/28 – Sunday, 12/31/24**. I/the organization will have all lights connected to a timer(s) set to "on" **4 pm– 10 pm** for the duration of the public "show" dates. There WILL be a People's Choice Contest (3 places) and an optional Open House 12/15. "Lights" viewing will be free to the public– Thanksgiving to New Years Day. There are some route and site changes this year– see the map.

Site decorating may **start Saturday, October 19** and must be **completed Sunday, Nov 24**. I/the organization understand the display should be anchored to **withstand 50 mph winds** and have **ground connections waterproofed**. Nailing to trees or permanently damaging the campsite is not allowed. Someone will check our site after a significant weather event and at least weekly to verify that lights are on and the display is standing. Consistently dark sites won't be invited back for 2025.

I/the organization accept(s) and assume(s) full liability for any loss or damage that may occur to my lights and decorations and will not hold Lake Antoine Park Partners nor the Dickinson County Parks responsible; display will not be removed prior to the end date of December 31, 2024 at 10 p.m. All decorations must be removed prior to park spring clean up activities: **April 15, 2025** (weather permitting); those left after that date will be removed and disposed of by park staff.
